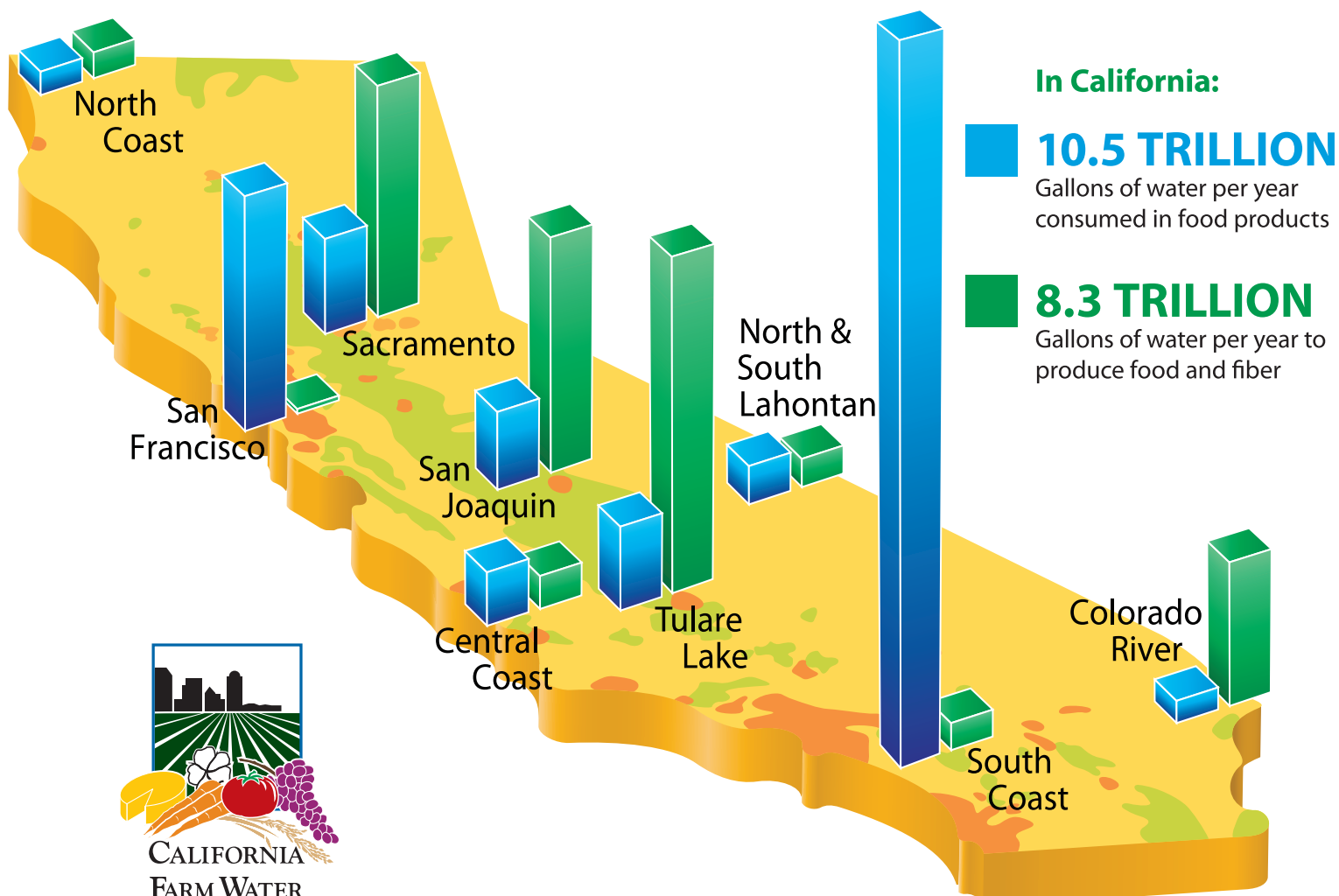


WHERE does farm water go?

The green bars below represent the amount of water used to irrigate California's 9.6 million acres of farmland. The blue bars represent the water consumed as food by the people in each region.
